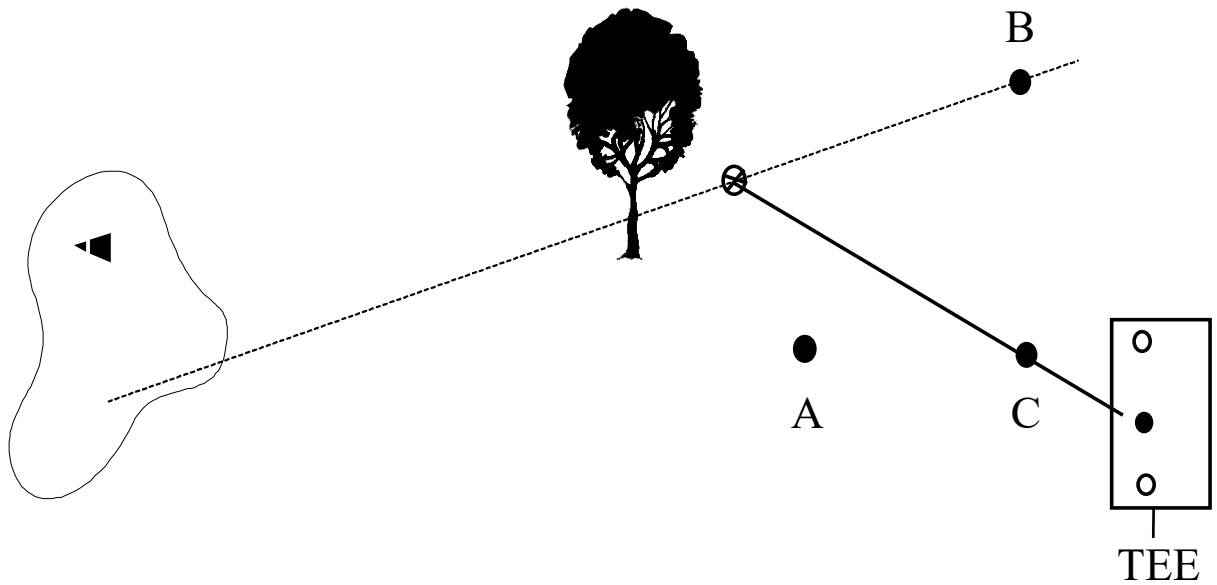
Unplayable Lie

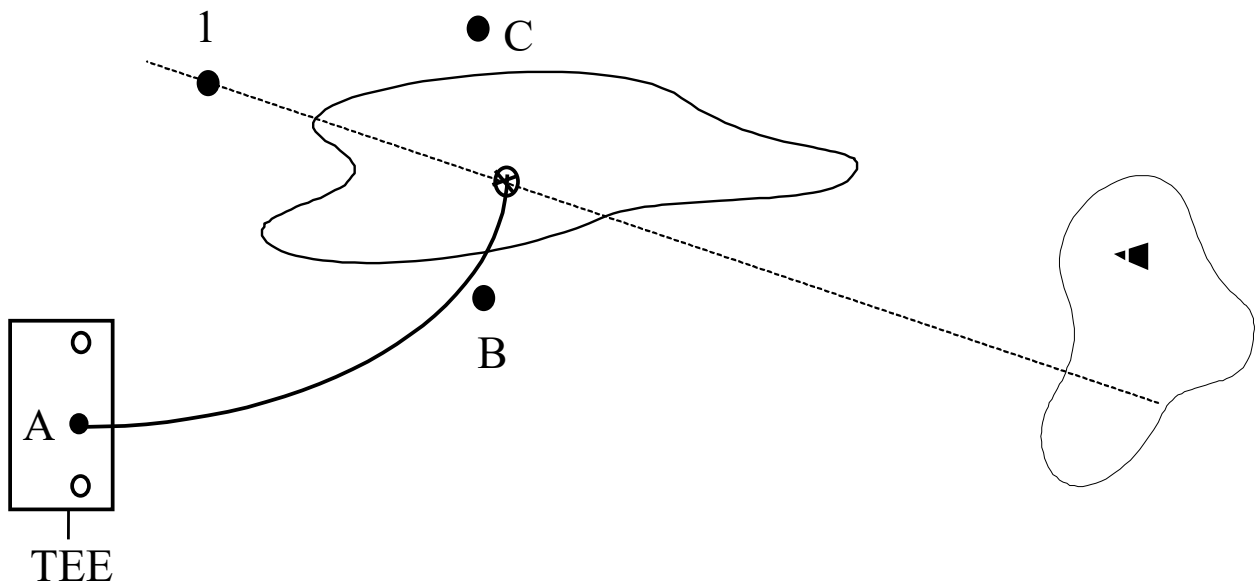
